Anti-Corruption Headlines 5 September 2023

- Two officials of the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment who were arrested in 2018 pleaded guilty. The officials colluded with abalone poachers by illegally selling back seized abalone and escorting the shipment. They were sentenced to 5 years imprisonment for charges of racketeering, corruption, money laundering and possession of abalone.
- The Gqeberha New Law Court has convicted and sentenced a man to 5 years imprisonment, suspended for 4 years on condition that he is not convicted of fraud during the period. In January 2014 he falsely lodged a claim that he was involved in a hit and run accident. He claimed that he had sustained injuries in a motor vehicle accident that never occurred. This led to an investigation by the Road Accident Fund (RAF) that uncovered discrepancies in the claim that nearly led to a loss of R750 000 to the institution.
