The Department of Community Safety and Transport Management invites applications for Examiners of Drivers Licence Learnership which seeks to capacitate unemployed youth with knowledge and skills for the year 2015 Details of the Learnership Programme are as follows:

A monthly stipend of **R1 800.00** per month will be offered for the duration of the Programme, as stipulated in terms of the DPSA's guide on Intern and Learnership Programmes.

NB. Learners who have previously been in a Learnership programme in the Public Service will not be considered.

- (a) Applications must be accompanied by signed and dated Z83, a recent updated comprehensive CV with names of three referees; originally certified copies of Grade 12 certificate, ID-document and required Driving License, Security Clearance from SAPS. Failure to submit the requested documents will result in the application not being considered.
- (b) All qualifications will be verified. Persons in possession of a foreign qualification must furnish this Department with an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA).
- (c) Candidates must indicate the number of the post/reference number in their applications.
- (d) Candidates requiring additional information regarding an advertised post, must direct their enquiries to Mr Gilford Malotane /Ms Khaile
- (e) Applications should be forwarded in time to the department since applications received after the closing date indicated below will as a rule not be accepted. Faxed and emailed applications are not accepted.
- (f) It will be expected of candidates to be available for selection interviews on a date, time and place as determined by the Department.
