A monthly stipend of **R3 000.00** per month will be offered for the duration of six(6) months until the end of the Programme, as stipulated in terms of the DPSA's guide on Intern and Learnership Programmes.

NB. Learners who have previously been in a Learnership programme in the Public Service will not be considered.

- (a) Applications must be accompanied by signed Z83, a recent updated comprehensive CV with names of three referees; originally certified copies of Grade 12, ID-document, required Driving License, Security Clearance from SAPS. **Failure to submit the requested documents will result in the application not being considered.**
- (b) All qualifications will be verified. Persons in possession of a foreign qualification must furnish this Department with an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA).
- (c) Candidates must indicate the reference number on their applications.
- (d) Applications should be forwarded in time to the department since applications received after the closing date indicated below will as a rule not be accepted. Faxed and emailed applications are not accepted.
- (e) It will be expected of candidates to be available for selection interviews on a date, time and place as determined by the Department.
- (f) The Department reserves the right not to make appointments.
- (g) Previous employment records will be verified. All appointments are subjected to a positive qualifications verifications as well as security clearance and vetting.
