SOME ROADS IN NORTH WEST ARE FLOODED AND DRIVERS ARE ADVISED TO BE CAREFUL

Heavy rains have caused some roads to be submerged in the North West Province, leading to traffic disruptions in some areas. Affected roads so far include R24 Rustenburg to Magaliesburg, N12 between Klerksdorp and Stilfontein and N18 outside Mafikeng towards Vryburg near Uplands.

Though no challenges have been experienced thus far, drivers are also advised to drive carefully on R 30 between Klerksdorp and Ventersdorp, and between Derby and Ventersdorp.

Other roads that experienced flooding before include R 503 Hartbeesfontein, N4 near Dinokana, N14 between Sannieshof and Delareyville and R 52 between Koster and Lichtenburg, and between Koster and Rustenburg.

The North West Department of Community Safety and Transport Management Traffic officers have been deployed to assist motorists. In badly affected roads like N18 outside Mahikeng, the stop-and-go measure is applied.
