Allow me to send my warm greetings and welcome to you all

Government's assistance. The assembly urged governments and organizations to observe the day. This day is now an official UN day.

ICAO is a UN body that works closely with other United Nations members including the World Meteorological Organization, the International Telecommunication Union, the Universal Postal Union, the World Health Organization and the International Maritime Organization

We are therefore equally excited that just few months ago after we have just activated our Airport which has not been working for many years, we have been given the opportunity to host this international event. I must also hasten to mention that we have an African Union Academy that is training people to be pilots both on commercial and private right here in our airport. We also have Air Traffic and Navigation Services Bursaries offered here, there is again training by South Africa Weather Services for you to be weather man. Again we have partnered with South Africa Express to train pilots and we already have three young people who are flying to qualify to be licensed pilots. SA Express is again training Air Hostess for the Airline who comes from this province. Great opportunities indeed that we have created here and looking forward to establish a multipurpose training centre that will do everything here.

But I believe that the more time you spend listening, learning and asking questions you will realize that we talking about things that you can also do because they are also done by human beings like yourself.
